

SCOOTER

Scooter is our 15 year old male Pacific harbor seal weighing in around 200 pounds. Pacific harbor seals are naturally found along the West coast of the United States as far north as Alaska and as far south as Mexico. Scooter began his formal training with the Mystic Aquarium in Connecticut early on and has since relocated to Oceans of Fun on a breeding loan. He and our female harbor seal, Satara, are expecting their first seal pup this spring!

In the wild, seals and sea lions live to be about 10-15 years old while their lifespan can double in a zoo or aquarium to their late 20s - early 30s because the animals have all the fish they can eat, do not have to worry about predators and we can provide them veterinary care when ever needed. At a very young age Scooter developed cataracts in both eyes. While we don't know the cause, we are able to monitor his eye's through cooperative husbandry training.

Scooter learns behaviors utilizing the same bridge and target training technique we use with all of our animals. However, we have adapted his training due to his impaired vision. Instead of using hand signals to ask Scooter to perform a behavior, trainers rely on their voice and tactile or touch signals to communicate with him. We also use a guide target in training to help Scooter move around the facility. Seals and sea lions have a natural ability to adapt to their environment. Scooter moves around his environment with confidence because of his trusting relationship with his trainers and is eager to learn new behaviors.

CONSERVATION CORNER Electronic Recycling

Electronics are the fastest-growing part of our waste stream today. As technology improves, millions of TVs, computers and other household electronics become obsolete each year. As you prepare for spring cleaning, remember that it is important to dispose of trash and unwanted materials properly. If you have old electronics, please remember to recycle them.

There are many reasons to recycle electronic waste such as cell phones, computers, printers, TVs, DVD players, fax machines and other electronic devices. Most states, including Wisconsin, have banned electronic items from landfills and incinerators requiring alternative disposal methods.

- Many electronics contain valuable, reusable materials like gold, steel, silver, copper, plastic and glass.
 Recycling old devices reduces the need for new materials and cuts down on greenhouse gas emissions associated with manufacturing.
- Recycling electronics helps to protect human and environmental health. Many devices also contain harmful materials such as lead, mercury, cadmium, chromium and chemical flame retardants. If disposed of improperly, these pollutants can effect the environment. Recycling electronics helps ensure that these materials are reused safely or disposed of properly.
- E-cycling is an important part of product stewardship.
 By recycling our old electronics, we share responsibility for the products we buy and use from the beginning to the end of their useful lives.

There are many local electronic recycling centers including Best Buy stores, that will accept electronic devices for disposal. Some facilities may charge disposal fees so it is always best to contact the recycling center to understand their policies and any fees that may apply prior to disposal.

- Reuse old clothing as cloths for cleaning and dusting. This will help you stretch your resources and keep waste out of landfills.








ARE YOU INTERESTED IN THE ANIMAL TRAINING FIELD?
