# WANT TO KNOW WHAT IT TAKES TO BE AN ANIMAL TRAINER?

Oceans of Fun, is proud to offer a one-of-a-kind experience for the ultimate animal lover! Learn what it really takes to be a marine mammal trainer in our *Animal Trainer Job Shadow Program!* 

Participants shadow a marine mammal trainer and assist with their daily routine. During this program, you'll play an active role in duties that make up a trainer's day. You will learn to:

- Prepare animal diets
- Observe and learn how to record animal behavior
- Provide enrichment toys such as frisbees and boomer balls to the animals. Watch them play and interact with one another!
- Discuss animal training and conservation topics
- Assist in animal husbandry or medical behavior sessions
- Feed our seals and sea lions
- Interact one-on-one with an animal pool-side by giving them hand signals and vocal cues

Advanced reservations are required. Job shadows are available from Labor Day to Memorial Day for anyone ages 13 and older. # **DIEGO**

Diego is our 6 year old sub-dominant male California Sea Lion. He currently weighs in around 200 pounds. Male California Sea Lions will weigh 600-900 pounds and reach lengths of 7-9 feet when they are fully grown. Young males explore their boundaries while learning to become dominant males that protect and defend their territory. Diego has learned over 50 behaviors in his 5 years of training and has recently mastered ball balancing! This behavior highlights a few natural adaptations that help sea lions survive in their environment. The whiskers on the side of Diego's nose have special nerve endings that help him sense where the ball is going to fall. Sea lions are very flexible because they do not have collar bones and have extra vertebrae in their back. He uses both his whiskers and his flexible neck to adjust to keep the ball on the tip of his nose. Congrats to Diego on this very impressive behavior that has taken him over a year to learn!

# MAKE OCEAN-FRIENDLY SEAFOOD CHOICES

Every year, humans consume over 80 million tons of seafood. This does not even include the fish animals in the wild need to eat. The take home message: we eat A LOT of fish!

It is easy to do your part to make more informed and sustainable choices in seafood with the help of the *Seafood Watch* Pocket Guide!



The *Seafood Watch* Pocket guide is designed to fit easily

in your wallet or purse and outlines the best choices in seafood. There is also an iPhone app that is free to download. The guide is updated twice a year to provide the most up-to-date information on healthy seafood choices for each region in the United States.

Scientists at the Monterey Bay Aquarium in California research to find the healthiest and most sustainable choices of seafood and compile the information into these handy pocket guides. There are 3 categories: Best Choices, Good Alternatives and Avoid.

Seafood Watch scientists look at fishing and farming practices, natural populations and health concerns to determine where each kind of fish will fit into the categories of the pocket guide.

These guides are a ready-resource to help you make informed choices the next time you purchase seafood at a store or restaurant. Just pull the guide out of your pocket or use the iPhone app and determine if the fish you want to purchase is a sustainable choice.

You may have to ask questions about where the fish comes from or the way the fish was caught, but its all about awareness. The more people who are talking about sustainable seafood, the healthier our world's oceans will become!
