


Slick

Slick is the oldest member of the Oceans of Fun family. At the age of 26, this dominant male California sea lion has spent most of his life performing and providing up close and personal experiences to guests at Oceans of Fun. Currently, Slick is weighing in at 450 pounds. With winter fast approaching, Slick is beginning to pack on the pounds and building a thick blubber layer to help stay warm this winter season.

In the wild, California sea lions only live to be between 10-15 years old due to predation, natural illness and hunting challenges. Seals and sea lions living in zoos and aquariums can live into their 30s because they do not have to worry about natural predators, they have all the fish they can eat and they are provided excellent medical attention. As an older animal, Slick developed a cataract in one of his eyes that impaired his vision. Thanks to positive reinforcement training, dedication and a trusting relationship with his trainers, veterinarians were able to successfully remove the cataract and the pain he was experiencing due to the medical condition.

Today, Slick continues to perform in educational presentations and participate in interactive programs with all ages year round at Oceans of Fun. He is a crowd favorite, impressing and inspiring all whom he meets. Stop by this winter season to meet and greet Slick and his flippered friends at Oceans of Fun!

CONSERVATION CORNER Join Oceans of Fun on the Journey of a Lifetime!

FOLLOW US ON A CONSERVATION MISSION TO PERU IN EFFORT TO COLLECT ECOLOGICAL INFORMATION TO HELP SAVE ENDANGERED SPECIES LIVING IN THE PUNTA SAN JUAN MARINE PROTECTED AREA.

This year, Oceans of Fun has joined in partnership with the Chicago Zoological Society in studying the populations of South American sea lions and the endangered South American fur seals in the Punta San Juan (PSJ) Marine Protected Area. Both facilities are committed to the development of veterinary field projects, conservation programs, and education programs.

For the past 5 years, the Chicago Zoological Society veterinary staff has developed multiple research projects with the Saint Louis Zoo and Peruvian colleagues at the Center for Environmental Sustainability at Cayetano Heredia University. The program aims to evaluate the population health of the wildlife and to develop cohesive conservation strategies. Since 2007, they have evaluated and collected samples from over 700 penguins, 150 seabirds, and 130 pinnipeds. Projects are focused on disease and toxicant exposure, reproductive success, population stability, population genetics, and overall population resilience to external threats. Oceans of Fun recognized the value and significance in this unique conservation project and in 2012 joined in partnership to assist financially as well as

physically in studying the Punta San Juan pinnipeds.

Located approximately 250 miles south of Lima, near San Juan de Marcona, the Punta San Juan Marine Protected Area supports key populations of many endangered and threatened species. This reserve is home to nearly half of the endangered Humboldt penguins in Peru. It contains several hundred thousand sea birds as a key nesting area. The reserve also has key rookeries for the South American sea lion and Peruvian fur seal, both of which have seen severe declines in Peruvian population sizes.
